

**Mission to Africa** Outreach #9 February 10, 2011 Via Town, Bomi County

**Tony:**

As we wrap up this mission, special thanks to all that supported us in prayer. Only eternity will tell of what you have done! Bless you all!

We headed out to our last outreach night for this mission. We have seen over the years entire communities converted thru **one Notable, Remarkable Miracle**. This last night was one of those times. There is usually someone in the community that has had a crippling disease all their life that the entire community knows about. In Via Town this was the case with a young blind boy, 7 years old, born into a Muslim family. The pastor of this church begged for the last crusade to be in the area around his church. The church was completely surrounded by Muslim families and 98% of the people in this community were Muslim. This evening Heaven ordained to establish this little church. Declarations were made in the Spirit and transformation happened. The boy's eyes were totally opened up tonight. He began to cry and then wail with thankfulness. His Muslim family wouldn't even come near when he was getting prayer but they let the boy come to see if maybe, just maybe, something might happen. When the parents heard the boy cry out they came from the sidelines running to see what had happened. When they saw the miracle, that their son could now see, they started crying and yelling out to all the other Muslims lined up around the perimeter of the meeting. They all started running to see what God had done. There were tears of exuberant joy. It was time to invite the Muslims of this community to come to Jesus. "What else can we do, we have seen the True Living God, Jesus is God, we will live for him now!!" **TONIGHT THE MUSLIMS OF THIS LITTLE COMMUNITY CAME TO JESUS!!** It was such a celebration. They said "We will be in this Christian Church now!! Wow, this is such a great event in this community.

It was a great finish to this mission. I am overjoyed to see the men of this team flowing in the Spirit in such powerful ways and to see the God of Our Salvation bring His Kingdom to this part of His creation. To see the pastors now walking in inexpressible joy absolutely knowing that they WILL bring the gospel of the kingdom to the remotest parts of this country and the WILL see OUR GOD REIGN!!!!
